



Notification to the Congregation

On May 29th at a Special Called Business Meeting, the church voted to authorize the Trustees to seek a loan from a bank to repair the air conditioning in the church sanctuary. While the Trustees arrange for the loan and sign the HVAC replacement contract, the GBBC Leadership Team has come up with the following plan in the interim. The Property Committee and IT Committee has been tasked appropriately to have in place by Sunday June 9th.

Beginning Sunday June 9 auxiliary fans will be operational in the sanctuary to minimize some of the discomfort experienced by the higher temperatures this summer. Some seating locations may be affected by the locations of the fans. In addition, the Prayer Chapel will be an alternative location for worship. Should you feel that you cannot tolerate the heat in the sanctuary you may worship in the air-conditioned Prayer Chapel where the worship service will be broadcast live. You will be able to see and hear all of the worship service activities. The auxiliary fans and live broadcasting to the Prayer Chapel will be in service until the air-conditioning is restored in the sanctuary. The Trustees and LT ask for your patience and grace during this time.
