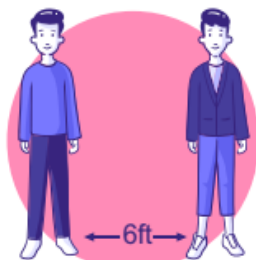

Let's Worship Together Safely
