STATE MISSIONS OFFERING: Every year in September, churches in the Baptist Convention of Maryland/Delaware unite together to pray and financially support ministries and initiatives that reach people with the Gospel in specific ways.

The SMO is collected annually, and contributions can be made at any time throughout the year. In 2025, the SMO Week of Prayer will be held from **September 14th to 21st**. During this week, our churches are asked to pray specifically for the initiatives supported by the SMO and to consider how the Lord may lead them to contribute.

Fellow Church Members, Committee Chairpersons, and Ministry leads - the time is nearly upon us for the preparation of the 2026 budget by the Budget & Finance Committee. If you are responsible for providing inputs for any budget line items, please note:

- those inputs are due to the church office or via email beginning Sept. 2nd thru NLT Friday Oct. 3rd.
- your inputs are strongly encouraged to be as detailed as possible to substantiate the requested amount for consideration in our budget formulation meeting.
- any form of input is acceptable (church provided form, typed up, hand written, emailed to office, handed in to office, etc.) as long as it contains your name, current year budget line name/number.

The budget preparation meeting is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 21st beginning at 6pm. Your inputs are utilized to create a pre-meeting budget spreadsheet which substantially improves efficiency and reduces the meeting time required. Please keep in mind that the budget formulation process can move some items around and it is possible the line numbers could be altered during the process. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

The 2026 Proposed Budget will be provided to you at least 2 weeks prior to the scheduled Nov. 12th business meeting where it will be voted on for approval.
