Wholehearted 4 – We Find What We Seek

Message from 6/1/25



Message Summary

Big Idea: Our spiritual purpose is to be constantly and continuously seeking God's Kingdom.

The Kingdom of God is wherever God reigns. God's Kingdom was inaugurated with Jesus' resurrection and with the outpouring of the Spirit. However, the Kingdom won't be fully here until Jesus returns. We are in between the times, and while we're here, we see glimpses of God reigning. However, there are instances where we don't see God reigning fully. (This is called the already/not yet of the Kingdom). So, our job, while we're in between the times, is to work toward bringing God's Kingdom on earth as it is in heaven. For example, wherever we see brokenness, we're to bring healing, justice, peace, and love.

- Can you share an example from your own life where you've seen a glimpse of God's Kingdom "already" present? Where in your life are you still longing for God's Kingdom to come more fully?
- Who in your life might be part of your eternal impact if you invested in a relationship with them more intentionally? What is one small "cup of cold water" act you can offer this week in Jesus' name?
