  - A. Grace through Faith
  - B. Not on our own
  - C. Not by Works

- II. Salvation should be evident by our works.
  - A. For we are God's Workmanship
  - B. Created in Christ for Good Works.

- Good Works mentioned in the passage are not the basis of salvation but are the evidence of our faith in Christ and the transformation He brings into our lives.
- 2. Believers become a new creation in Christ, designed to live out the good works God has set for them.
