Romans 12:1-2

- **For the last 2 weeks we have been looking at what is required to be a Disciple. Specifically looking at what is required for Discipleship.**
- **I called it the 4 S's of Discipleship. What are they?**
 - **Salvation**
 - **Service**
 - **Sacrifice**
 - **Suffering.**
- **We began by looking at Salvation. We talked about how Salvation is much more than just getting Salvation (Ephesians 2:8-10).**
 - **Salvation is a gift from God to never be taken for granted**
 - **Salvation should be evident by the works we do.**
 - **Salvation means to live out our faith.**
