 - A. The Improper Use of the Law is to try to be saved by keeping it.
 - 1. The Mosaic Law is Not Primarily for Believers.

- a) The Law of Moses reveals God's nature, as it is his self revelation.
- b) The Mosaic Law reveals Christ.
- c) The Mosaic Law reveals continuing standards of righteousness for all generations
- d) The Mosaic Law reveals wisdom principles
- B. The Proper Use of God's Law is to Bring Conviction of Sin.
 - 1. The Mosaic Law is Primarily for Unbelievers.
 - 2. Why has God given his law to the unrighteous? What does it do?
 - a) The Law convicts the unrighteous of sin.
 - b) The Law deters people from sin through the promise of judgment.
 - c) The Law reveals one's need for the Gospel.
