



God's Design for the Church Grace Abounding (1 Timothy 1:12-17)

- I. We all have a Testimony to share. We should Often recall our own experience of the Gospel.**
 - A. Recalling our experience of the Gospel will make us Thankful (v. 12):

 - A. Saul the persecutor was transformed into Paul the Apostle. And his case was no exception. In verse 16 he says that his conversion is a model of what God can do with any sinner. None is beyond God's**

abundant grace. When God's grace in Christ floods into a life, it always radically transforms a person.
